UPDATED HANGAR LEASE AGREEMENTS DUE THIS MONTH

Beginning Oct. 9, all tenants (hangar buildings 120-150) will need to sign a new lease agreement during this month. Old (expired) lease agreements are valid for ONLY a month-to-month tenancy, and could be terminated on a 60-day notice. Tenants **MUST** have an updated lease agreement signed and filed with airport authority by October 31. A current aircraft airworthiness certificate must accompany the agreement.
